Tinnitus	Waechter and Jönsson	2022	Meta-analysis comparing hearing aids fit with real-ear vs. not; greater reduction in tinnitus outcome scores shown for real-ear-fit hearing aids
Tinnitus	Lee et al.	2022	Compared hearing aids and counseling vs. counseling alone; tinnitus improved in both scenarios, but more change found with hearing aids and counseling
Tinnitus	Henry et al.	2017	Hearing aids and tinnitus maskers provide some improvement in the functional effects of tinnitus, though not one device showed improvement over others
Tinnitus	Sanders et al.	2023	Both new and experience hearing aid users experienced a reduced impact of tinnitus on daily life by wearing hearing aids
Listening Effort	Ohlenforst et al.	2017	Systematic review (41 studies) examining (1) if hearing impairment affects listening effort and (2) if hearing aids affect listening effort
Listening Effort	Pichora-Fuller et al.	2016	Workshop defining current concepts and frameworks related to effortful listening and recommending future research directions
Listening Effort	McGarrigle et al.	2014	Article discussing the various methods of measuring listening effort and listening fatigue
Listening Effort	Hornsby et al.	2016	Description of fatigue and its relationship to hearing loss, as well as consequences of listening fatigue
Listening Effort	Blümer et al.	2024	Recent study measuring listening effort using all three assessment methods
